Introduction to ResponseForce1 (RF1)

Director Tate introduced Ed and Jay who came to Boulder to assist OEM in developing and completing the ESF Annexes and the basic Emergency Operations Plan. While they are here, they will be meeting with various ESF leads and support agencies to provide guidance where needed. Ed and Jay gave a brief overview of ResponseForce1 capabilities and services that include planning, response and mitigation of major incidents and disasters.

U.S Northern Command

U.S. Northcom Headquarters is located at Peterson Air Force Base in Colorado Springs and provides civil support during domestic disasters that overwhelm local resources. During Katrina, there was no guidance in the National Search and Rescue (SAR) Plan for a catastrophic incident. When Katrina struck, Northcom provided catastrophic incident search & rescue but had to provide “on the fly” assistance. Since Katrina, a Catastrophic Incident SAR (CIS) addendum has been developed and added to the National Search and Rescue Manual (April 2008). - Director Tate noted the EOC would be activated starting on Sunday, August 24 through Friday, August 29. He asked that all ESFs provide a point of contact in case the situation requires additional support.

- Mike Richen of BCPH noted there is a Hazmat Workshop Planning Subcommittee meeting scheduled immediately after LEPC on June 16.
